Press Briefing Disseminates General Situation of Polling and Preliminary Election Result for 3rd Mandate Senate Election

On the 29th of January 2012, at 17:30 p.m., the National Election Committee (NEC) announced that the general situation of the polling on the polling day proceeded in secure and safe manner under the observation of 131 political party representatives, 1,432 international and national observers, and 200 international and national journalists.

H.E Im Suosdey, NEC chairperson, said that the polling on January 29 was normally conducted although there is rain in some provinces at the seaside. The polling station opened regularly and the general situation was un-noticeable. In the briefing, His Excellency declared that the preliminary election result of eight (8) regions as stated in the table of the preliminary result of the third mandate Senate Election dated on January 29, 2012 was spread to the participants in the briefing.

According to the table of the preliminary result, it showed that a total of the valid votes of eight (8) regions is 11,383 among which CPP received 8,880 votes, while SRP got 2,503 votes. The name on the voter list is 11,470 and the turnout is 1,412. By this figure, 58 voters did not go to vote.

It should be remembered that according to the election calendar, the declaration of the official election result, the seat allocation and the elected candidates will be held on February 04, 2012 if there is no complaint. However, if there is a complaint, the announcement of the official election result will be released on March 05, 2012, the final deadline.
